

THINGS TO KNOW FOR YOUR LEAF FARM VISIT

We offer field trips during the **spring, fall, and winter!**

April, May, September and October - Options could include workshops, outdoor farm work, preserving/cooking in our commercial kitchen, and a farm tour

November-March - Options could include workshops, preserving/cooking in our commercial kitchen, and work in our greenhouse

DRESSING FOR THE FARM

- **Dress in layers.** Pack a sweatshirt or light jacket. Hats and warm jackets are recommended on cooler days.
- **Wear comfortable shoes and clothes that can get dirty.** We try to incorporate as much work outside in the fields as possible! Shoes should be sturdy, close-toe or boots with tread on the bottom.
- **Watch the weather forecast.** We try to do as much programming outside as possible! Boots and a water resistant jacket with a hood are recommended. In very rainy conditions, the workshop will move to a covered space.

Minimum number of students: **8**
Maximum number of students: **30**

If you would like a group larger than 30 to visit the farm, please reach out and we are happy to brainstorm a two-part visit to accommodate everyone.

WHAT TO BRING

- **If you are staying for a full day - students should bring their own lunch and snacks.** We are a leave no trace facility and do not provide trash or recycling receptacles. Please help us keep our farm clean!
- **A water bottle** - it is so important to stay hydrated!
- **A hat and sunscreen on sunny days.** Sunscreen should be applied before students get on the bus - we want to avoid sunscreen touching the plants!
